



Uniform

Following a meeting of the Sumner Running Club committee it was agreed that we needed to set out clearer guidelines as to what is acceptable for the shorts component of the Sumner Running Club Uniform. We are a club with high standards and it is important our uniform looks appropriate without making it onerous on parents.

Outlined below then is what we have agreed and what will be deemed required for all ongoing Saturday morning competitions:

In the book our shorts are identified as blue or black so what is totally acceptable are:

- 1) Plain black or blue sports shorts or bike pants
- 2) The two-toned club blue shorts that have the same blue colouring as the club singlet (we have these available free of charge for people who need them; they are also our "emergency" shorts should a change of clothing be required).
- 3) Skins (plain black / yellow stitching)

What we also accept are blue shorts (the same colour as the singlet) or black shorts with

- 4) **Small, discrete** logos like the white/silver grey manufacturer logos such as Asics, Nike, New Balance
- 5) The Adidas stripes in blue, black or white
- 6) The dark blue with white writing "Sumner School" on the Sumner School running shorts

What is no longer acceptable are:

- 7) Additional colours on the black or blue shorts/bike pants including
 - Coloured trims
 - Other coloured stripe(s) on the sides of shorts
- 8) Franchise logos such as league, rugby, basketball as these are not accepted by CCA & NZA
- 9) White or coloured skins / tights other than those specified above
